I **allow** my network members to mutually enrich one another out of their experiences and knowledge through events and mentoring

Sharing will be the heart of your mission

I **commit** my members by forging mutual trust bonds and by offering room for solidarity, exchange and sharing

You will indulge your members as well as your family

I **welcome and include** each of my members so that they all feel at home and I am responsive to their requests for them to become actors in our community

You will guide your members throughout their whole career

I **provide** the tools to learn, exchange and help each other in order to care for them throughout their professional life: my network is a real guide in the careers of my members

You will breathe life into your network

I **galvanise** the life and activity of my community, and am always there to start or assist activities and events with group leaders and volunteers

You will bring out your network and its members

I **recognise** the value of my network and of its members, and I bring it out in my communication both internally and with my partners (companies, schools, associations, foundations, etc.)

You will show attentiveness to your community

I **regularly analyse** the life and activity of my network, I show attentiveness to it and I adjust my services to be in the perfect harmony with its needs and expectations

You will humanise your network

I place people at the center of my concerns and I promote exchanges and meetings to make my network exist in real life through face-to-face events
